Rosé of Pinot Noir 2022, Petaluma Gap, Sonoma Coast		\$12	\$32	\$25.60
Grapes are sourced from the cold, windy Petaluma Gap close to the Pacific Ocean along the Sonoma coast. This rosé has an alluring coral tint and aromas of orange blossom and candied cherries. On the palate, it's dry and crisp with layered flavors of strawberries and red apples.				
WHITE WINES				
Chenin Blanc 2022, St. Helena, Napa Valley		\$13	\$33	\$26.40
On the palate, pear, chamomile, and beeswax are balanced with a mouth-watering acidity and satisfying finish. Chenin Blanc is classically produced in South Africa and France's Loire Valley, and has the versatility to produce an array of styles including bone dry, sparkling, and sweet dessert.				
Albariño 2023, Dunlap Vyd., Carneros, Napa Valley		\$14	\$36	\$28.80
Grapes are sourced from the cool, maritime-climate area of Carneros in Southern Napa. The nose is filled with powerful aromas of white peach, bubblegum, and jasmine. On the palate, find tropical notes of mango and pineapple with fresh acidity, and a finish that is crisp, saline, and dry.				
Sauvignon Blanc 2022, Select Vyds., Napa Valley		\$13	\$33	\$26.40
Largely from the Stewart Vineyard, which is at sea level alongside the Napa River estuary. It's a late developing site with a cool climate that results in Sauvignon Blanc with gooseberry and grapefruit flavors and crisp acidity.				
Chardonnay 2021, Napa Valley		\$15	\$39	\$31.20
Grown next to Hole 3 on Chardonnay Golf Course in Southern Napa Valley. Our winemaker makes a restrained style with a touch of oak and minimal malolactic (buttery) influence. Finishes with pear, apple, and a hint of tropical flavors.				
RED WINES				
Pinot Noir 2021, Senemar Vyd., Napa Valley		\$18	\$41	\$32.80
Light, elegant, and fragrant. A classic expression from the cool climate of southern Napa. Abounds with a complex bouquet of strawberry and dried cranberry with undertones of exotic floral and red rose. Delightful and balanced from its silky first sip to its long finish.				
Sangiovese 2020, Pauli Ranch, Mendocino		\$15	\$39	\$31.20
The most planted grape variety of Italy. This vintage shows aromas of sour cherries, figs, and light hints of cocoa powder. On the palate, this versatile food wine is medium bodied with good structure and a friendly soft finish.				

Syrah 2021, Feliz Creek Ranch, Hopland Mendocino	\$17	\$40	\$32
Flavors of black cherry and pomegranate with alluring aromas of cracked black pepper and a faint hint of smoked meats on the finish. Round and inviting on the palate with moderate tannins.			
Zinfandel 2021, Hoot Owl Vyd., Alexander Valley, Sonoma	\$15	\$39	\$31.20
Grown in the warm Alexander Valley in eastern Sonoma, this Zinfandel has a dark ruby hue. Rich and inviting aromas of cherry, blackberry, and cacao are complemented with subtle notes of orange rind. On the palate, this full bodied wine has smooth, rich tannins and a balanced profile.			
Merlot 2020, Nelson Vyd., Bennett Valley, Sonoma	\$15	\$39	\$31.20
Soft and supple on the palate and long on flavor and nuance. It features aromas of dark plums with hints of espresso and a pop of clove on the finish. Bennett Valley has a cool climate for ripening Merlot grapes to their full potential.			
Bird Rock Blend #4 2021, Fore Family Vyds., Lake County	\$20	\$46	\$36.80
A GSM blend, 36% Grenache brings fruit and juiciness, 26% Syrah delivers darker colors and enhanced spice notes, and 38% Mourvedre offers balanced tannin and structure. All work together leading to a complex and well rounded wine. Grown in volcanic soils at high altitude.			
Petit Verdot 2021, Romeo Vyd., Calistoga, Napa Valley	\$21	\$49	\$39.20
Usually a blending grape, this wine opens with aromas of plum, cedar, and hints of violet. It's an elegant, well-balanced, full-bodied wine. The palate has a rustic mix of pomegranate and cranberries and ends with a long, satisfying finish.			
Cabernet Sauvignon 2021, Romeo Vyd., Calistoga, Napa Valley	\$24	\$59	\$47.20
Another example of the world-class wines that Napa produces. A classic full-bodied wine with grippy tannins balanced with a long dry finish. With minimal oak usage, the palate has cassis and blackberry flavors while a spice component and hints of herbaceousness round out the wine.

DESSERT WINE: **Vin de Constance** 2015, Klein Constantia, South Africa Famed and celebrated dessert wine from our former vineyard. Historically produced since 1685, this dessert wine has notes of vanilla, apricot, and crème brûlée. **\$15 per 1 oz**

SPARKLING WINE: **Graham Beck Brut Rosé**, South Africa Bottle-fermented sparkling wine from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. **\$50/bottle**
